FAQs: HOW IS PAYROLL FOR A MONTHLY EMPLOYEE PROCESSED?

The following is a general explanation of how theth Æarned Salary Advance (ESA) and the 10th RegularSalary Payroll is processed for an EMUHSIassified monthly salaryemployee with a <u>basic payroll status</u>.

1. When do Monthly Employees get paid for the current "Pay Periody"cle?

As a monthly employee, our earnings paperiod begins on the shandends on the last day of the month (i.e. 1/120 - 1/31/20).

Your monthly salary for this pay period is paid to you on the dDthe following month (i.e. Pay period of 1/1/20 - 1/31/20 is paidon 2/10/20). Additionally, you have the benefit of receiving aportion of your salary as an Earn and Larra Advance (ESA) on the 25^{h} of the current pay period (i.e. 1/25/20), which will be deducted from your pay on the 10/20).

2 What is an Earned Salary Advance?

A portion of your monthly salary is advanced to youthoor 25^{h} of the monthas an Earned Salary Advance (ESA). It is only a partial "advance" of your mountailary. For example, ESA on 1/25/20 is an advance of your mountain which is due of you on 2/10/20 (for the pay period of 1/1/20 - 1/31/20).

3 Who receives an Earned Salar Advance?

Regular monthly Classified employees will receive an Earned Salary Advance (ESAEST his intended for employees that are scheduled to work the month.

Employees out on Indust **lia**njury and/or receiving Worker **C**ompensation may not be eligible for the ESA. Also, some empl**e**semay not receiv
